SUBJECT: Appointment to the Parks, Recreation & Beautification Commission

RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt the Resolution appointing **Jerry Pastor** to the *unexpired* term on the Parks, Recreation & Beautification Commission, which is scheduled to expire on March 31, 2020; and introduce **Commissioner Pastor** to the City Council and members of the audience.

BACKGROUND

At the City Council meeting of October 16, 2017, the Council made appointments to fill two vacancies on the Parks, Recreation & Beautification Commission and provided direction for staff to maintain the name of Jerry Pastor on a list that identified Mr. Pastor as the *next appointee* in the event of an unscheduled vacancy on the Parks, Recreation & Beautification Commission. Mr. Pastor was among those candidates who were interviewed on October 10, 2017 by the Advisory Body Screening Committee, comprised of Mayor John Shoals, Council Member Barbara Nicolls, and Parks, Recreation & Beautification Commission Chair Walt French.

On February 14, 2018, the City received written notice from Commissioner Maalea Quirk notifying the City that she would no longer be available to continue serving on the Commission after June 2018. Staff therefore contacted Mr. Pastor and received confirmation that he was still interested in being considered for appointment to fill a vacancy of an unexpired term of office on the Parks, Recreation & Beautification Commission. Mr. Pastor also confirmed that he would be in attendance at the meeting when the City Council considered his appointment to the Commission.

FISCAL IMPACT

There is no anticipated fiscal impact from the recommended action.

ALTERNATIVES

The City Council has the following alternatives to consider:

1. Adopt the Resolution confirming the appointment pursuant to Council direction at the October 16, 2017 meeting and as recommended by the Advisory Body Screening Committee; or
2. Provide alternative direction to staff.

PUBLIC NOTIFICATION

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVER BEACH, CALIFORNIA, APPOINTING JERRY PASTOR TO SERVE ON THE PARKS, RECREATION & BEAUTIFICATION COMMISSION

WHEREAS, the Parks, Recreation and Beautification Commission was formed with the adoption of Ordinance No. 05-02 to be a body of five lay citizens; and

WHEREAS, the citizen advisory committee process is an effective means of gathering community input on matters pertaining to parks and public recreation services; and

WHEREAS, one (1) vacancy currently exists on the Commission due to the resignation of Commissioner Maalea Quirk from an unexpired four-year term of office; and

WHEREAS, at the City Council meeting of October 16, 2017, the Council reviewed recommendations from the Advisory Body Screening Committee (comprised of Mayor John Shoals, Council Member Barbara Nicolls, and Parks, Recreation & Beautification Commission Chair Walt French) from interviews held on Tuesday, October 10, 2017; and

WHEREAS, at the recommendation of the Advisory Body Screening Committee the Council provided direction for staff to maintain the name of Jerry Pastor on a list that identified Mr. Pastor as the *next appointee* in the event of an unscheduled vacancy on the Parks, Recreation & Beautification Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Grover Beach reaffirms the recommendation of the Advisory Body Screening Committee and hereby appoints **Jerry Pastor** to serve on the Parks, Recreation & Beautification Commission for the remainder of the unexpired four-year term of office, scheduled to expire on May 31, 2020.
