**Weekly Construction Update: Week of July 23, 2018**

The City is continuing the multi-year project to rehabilitate streets utilizing voter approved bond funds generated by Measure K. More information regarding Measure K and future projects can be found on the City's website which may be accessed by following the link below:

1. The following work will take place on **Long Branch Avenue**, between South 3rd Street and South 10th Street, over the next two (2) weeks:
  - Demolition of existing concrete at corners, between South 7th Street and South 10th Street
  - Grading and placement of forms for new corner ramps, between South 7th Street and South 10th Street
  - Installation of corner ramps, between South 7th Street and South 10th Street
2. The following work will take place in the northwest section of the City over the next two (2) weeks:
  - Installation of corner ramps and concrete improvements on **Front Street**, between 1st Street and Ocean View Avenue
  - Installation of concrete curb and gutter on the west side of **Front Street**
  - Installation of curb ramps and concrete improvements on **Ocean View Avenue**, between Front Street and North 4th Street
  - Relocation of water meter boxes in the 800 block of Front Street
  - Removal of Existing Asphalt on Front Street and Carmelde Lane will occur this week
  - Paving of Front Street and Carmelde Lane is expected to begin the week of August 13th.

This status update is intended to inform the public on the status of the Measure K-14 Street Rehabilitation and Repair Project. Field conditions and work progress are monitored daily and are subject to change daily. As a result, the dates indicated in this update are also subject to change. Schedule and location information is most accurate within three weeks of the date of this posting. Information will be updated weekly.
