SEISMIC RETROFIT and REHABILITATION OF RESERVOIR NO. 2

Bids are required for the entire work described herein. All bids are to be compared on the basis of the estimated quantities of work to be done contained in this proposal.

No bid will be accepted from a Contractor who has not been licensed in accordance with the provisions of State law. All bids must be made on a proposal form furnished by the City.

The successful bidder shall furnish a payment bond, a performance bond and a Certificate of Liability Insurance as required by these Special Provisions.

Pursuant to Section 1773.2 of said Code said rates of wages are on file at City Hall and are available to any interested party on request.
