The Purpose of The RWQCB Meeting: The Water Board staff will identify and discuss suspected sources of beneficial use impacts in areas drained by storm drain systems in the Grover Beach watershed. The meeting shall provide a forum for Stakeholder and City representatives to hear the Board's findings and discuss and disclose additional storm water quality information.

The Purpose of This Notice Being Sent to You:

California cities and counties are required by federal legislation and the State to prepare Storm Water Management Programs (SWMP) to address water quality concerns in their jurisdictional areas. The City of Grover Beach and other Central Coast municipalities are in the preparation process directed by the Central Coast Regional Water Board.

You have been identified as a 'Stakeholder' who may be affected by the City of Grover Beach SWMP. A 'Stakeholder' may be a party interested in water quality or impacts resulting from water quality measures implemented as a result of a SWMP.

It is anticipated that SWMPs may impact the following activities in Central Coast cities and counties. The following list contains potential impacts and is not inclusive of all potential impacts.
