The public is invited to attend and participate in a workshop on the Draft Update of the Housing Element of the General Plan. The workshop will take place on Wednesday, June 17, 2009 at 6:30 PM at the City Hall Council Chambers. The consultants who prepared the plan will present a summary of their findings and recommendations, followed by an informal discussion of issues and ideas. However, no formal action will be taken at the workshop. Interested persons may attend and make oral presentations to the City staff and the consultant who prepared the Draft Update.

The Housing Element contains the City's goals, policies, and action items relevant to providing housing to its residents. State Law requires that the Housing Element be updated every 5 years, and the Housing Element must be updated by August 31, 2009.
