## **NOMINATION PERIOD TO BEGIN FOR CITY COUNCIL CANDIDATES**

GROVER BEACH: The nomination period for Council Candidates for the November 7, 2006 General Municipal Election begins on Monday, July 17, 2006. The Election will be to fill **two (2) seats** on the City Council. The nomination period will run from **July 17 through August 11, 2006**. Nomination packets may be obtained from the City Clerk beginning July 17, 2006. If either incumbent does not file for re-election by August 11, the nomination period will be **extended for five days to Wednesday, August 16, 2006**.

Candidates must live in Grover Beach and be registered voters of the City. In accordance with the City's Master Fee Schedule, the filing fee for nomination papers is \$25, plus an optional \$275 deposit for printing Candidate Statements of Qualifications in the sample ballot. Candidates must also file a Statement of Economic Interests (Form 700) and Campaign Statements as required by the Political Reform Act of 1974.

Council Members receive a stipend of \$300/month. They are expected to attend City Council meetings the first and third Mondays of each month and any special meetings that may be necessary. They are also assigned to various committees and commissions throughout the County and represent the City at various functions.

Council Members also serve as the Board of Directors to the City's Improvement Agency and Financing Authority. Board Members receive \$30/meeting for each Improvement Agency meeting at which Agency business is conducted. There is no monetary compensation for serving on the Financing Authority.
