City of Grover Beach Extends Holiday Closures

City Manager Bob Perrault announced that the City of Grover Beach will be closed on December 24, 25, and 26, 2008, as well as on January 1 and 2, 2009. The Grover Beach City Council authorized the extended closures at the Council meeting held on December 15, 2008. Normally scheduled holiday closures for the City would be December 24th and 25th and January 1st.

The action of the Council adds Friday, December 26th and Friday, January 2nd to the regular holiday closure dates for a total of two additional days. The closures were authorized in an effort to save money. According to City Manager Bob Perrault, "It is anticipated that the City will save money by closing on the two successive Fridays. Costs will be saved due to the fact that the heat will be turned down and the lights turned off. Expenditures for fuel will also be minimized."

The closures will primarily affect employees working at City Hall and in Public Works. Employees working in the essential services, including Police and Fire, will be on duty during their regular shifts.

For those employees working in City Hall these will not be additional paid holidays; employees will be required to use accrued vacation time for the two Fridays that City Hall is closed. All services at City Hall will resume on Monday, December 29th and again on Monday, January 5th at 8:00 a.m.
