Council Member Versaw Announces His Pending Resignation from the Grover Beach City Council

Current Grover Beach City Council Member, former Mayor, and former Chair of the City's Planning Commission, Larry Versaw announced his intention to resign his seat on the City Council. His intention was contained in a memo presented to the City Council on Monday, March 19, 2007. Council Member Versaw and his wife, Arlene, a current Planning Commissioner, are moving out of Grover Beach in the very near future. State law requires elected officials to maintain residency within City limits.

Noting his reason for leaving, Council Member Versaw said, "A personal opportunity presented itself that I could not ignore. It happened so fast and I leave the Council with mixed emotions. There are new opportunities opening in my life that I look forward to, but a lot of City work of which I have personal interest in that is not yet complete, and I am sorry for that. I will always have an emotional tie to Grover Beach."

Council Member Versaw was elected to the City Council in November 2004. Within 30 days of commencement of the vacancy, the City Council will need to fill the vacancy or call for a special election to fill the vacancy.
