FIREWORKS STAND PERMIT PROCESS OPENS

The Fireworks Stand Permit process for selling safe and sane fireworks for the July 4th Independence Day Celebration is scheduled to open **Tuesday, April 11, 2006**. Applications may be filed with the City Clerk's Office between Tuesday, April 11, 2006 through Wednesday, May 31, 2006 during normal business hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday (City Hall offices will be closed on Monday, May 29, 2006 in observance of Memorial Day). Only non-profit, Grover Beach based organizations are eligible to apply. A maximum of four (4) fireworks stands will be permitted within the City limits, and no organization may obtain more than one permit. Pursuant to Ordinance No. 05-04, the Grover Beach Chamber of Commerce shall have the right of first refusal for one (1) permit, and the Grover Beach Police and Fire Associations shall have the right of first refusal to share one (1) permit.

Fireworks sales will be allowed at approved fireworks stands for a seven-day period from 12 Noon on June 28th through 12 Noon on July 5th per GBMC Article III, Section 3992 (17).
