**É NOTICE OF COMMISSION VACANCIES É
PLANNING COMMISSION
PARKS, RECREATION AND BEAUTIFICATION COMMISSION**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Grover Beach encourages residents to apply for positions on City Commissions and Committees that have vacancies. When vacancies occur, the City actively recruits applicants for the positions by publishing Notices of Vacancies in the local newspapers and posting the notice in the City's three (3) public posting locations.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that:

Three (3) vacancies exist on the Planning Commission. Two vacancies are for *expired* four-year terms that will expire on May 31, 2009. One vacancy is for an *unexpired* four-year term expiring on May 31, 2007. The Planning Commission is a body of seven citizens that meet on a monthly basis, usually the second Tuesday of each month.

The Planning Commission is a planning agency authorized by law to grant or deny land use approvals. The Planning Commission also reviews and makes recommendations on the community's General Plan. Major areas of involvement are real estate development projects and business uses.

Seven (7) vacancies exist on the newly formed **Parks, Recreation and Beautification Commission**. Three (3) Commission terms will expire on March 31, 2009; two (2) Commission terms will expire on March 31, 2008; and two (2) Commission terms will expire on March 31, 2007. Commission terms filled thereafter will be for four-year periods with terms expiring at staggered intervals on March 31. The Parks, Recreation and Beautification Commission is a body of seven citizens that is scheduled to meet on a monthly basis, usually the 4th Thursday of each month at 6:30 p.m.

The Parks, Recreation and Beautification Commission serves as an advisory body to the City Council and the Parks and Recreation Department regarding parks, recreation, community events, and beautification efforts. The Commission is actively involved with the Parks and Recreation Department in conducting special events throughout the year.

Applications are available at the City Clerk's Office, Grover Beach City Hall, 154 South Eighth Street, Grover Beach. Applicants will be reviewed and candidates interviewed by a screening committee before appointments are made by the Grover Beach City Council.
