☛ NOTICE OF COMMISSION VACANCIES ☛ **PLANNING COMMISSION**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Grover Beach encourages residents to apply for positions on City Commissions and Committees that have vacancies. When vacancies occur, the City actively recruits applicants for the positions by publishing Notices of Vacancies in the local newspapers and posting the notice in the City's three (3) public posting locations.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that:

- **One (1) vacancy currently exists** on the Planning Commission due to the resignation of a Commissioner for an unexpired four-year term that will expire on May 31, 2010.
- **One (1) vacancy is scheduled to occur** when an existing four-year term expires on May 31, 2007. The appointment to this term will be for a four-year term, expiring on May 31, 2011.

The Planning Commission is a body of seven citizens that meet on a monthly basis, usually the second Tuesday of each month.

The Planning Commission is a planning agency authorized by law to grant or deny land use approvals. The Planning Commission also reviews and makes recommendations on the community's General Plan. Major areas of involvement are real estate development projects and business uses.

Applications are available at the City Clerk's Office, Grover Beach City Hall, 154 South Eighth Street, Grover Beach and on the City's website at www.grover.org. From the website, click on the word "Government" and then the words "Advisory Bodies". Applicants will be reviewed and candidates interviewed by a screening committee before appointments are made by the Grover Beach City Council.
