## **Crosswalk Traffic Enforcement Detail**

**DATE/TIME:** Feb. 18<sup>th</sup> through Feb. 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2008  
**LOCATION:** West Grand Ave. in Grover Beach  
**TYPE:** **Crosswalk Traffic Enforcement Detail**

### **DESCRIPTION OF INCIDENT:**

During the week of **February 18 - February 22, 2008**, officers from the Grover Beach Police Department will initiate a pedestrian decoy operation on West Grand Avenue in Grover Beach. The objective is to enforce traffic laws pertaining to motorists who do not stop for a pedestrian in a marked crosswalk.

During the designated traffic enforcement period, a plain clothes GBPD officer will be assigned to walk across West Grand Ave. in marked crosswalks at various times to determine if oncoming traffic will stop. If motorists do not yield the right-of-way to the pedestrian in the crosswalk they may be stopped and cited by additional officers who will be monitoring the intersection in nearby patrol cars.

The fines for failing to yield the right-of-way to a pedestrian in a crosswalk range from \$130 to \$340.

The Grover Beach Police Department would like to encourage motorists to stop for pedestrians in all marked crosswalks or at intersections where a pedestrian has the right-of-way.
