Grover Beach City Council Schedules Special Workshop To Discuss Traffic Issues and Storm Water Management Plan (SWMP)

The Grover Beach City Council has scheduled a special workshop on **Thursday, December 4, 2008** beginning at **6:30 p.m.** at Grover Beach City Hall, 154 South 8th Street, to discuss the following items:

1. A Traffic Study Conducted by Omni-Means Regarding Three Specific Areas in the City and the Proposed Solutions:
 - Angled Parking on West Grand Avenue (between 6th & 12th Streets);
 - Traffic Calming on Margarita Avenue (between Charles Street & North 12th Street); and
 - Pedestrian Crossing at the Intersection of Brighton Avenue & Oak Park Boulevard.
2. The Draft Storm Water Management Program (SWMP) that the City is processing in order to comply with the State's Regional Water Quality Control permit requirements.
