



NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

Sealed proposals will be received at the office of the City Clerk, City of Grover Beach, 154 South 8th Street, Grover Beach, CA 93433, (805) 473-4568, until 2:00 p.m., on **Tuesday, May 20, 2008**, at which time they will be publicly opened and read for performing work in accordance with the specifications therefore, to which special reference is made as follows:

SOUTH COUNTY TRANSIT HUB PROJECT, PHASE I

Description of Work: The Contractor shall furnish, in accordance with the Contract Documents, all materials, labor and equipment, necessary for the construction of the SOUTH COUNTY TRANSIT HUB PROJECT, PHASE I, together with all appurtenant work and facilities, as shown on the Plans and as specified herein. The work to be done consists, in general, of furnishing all materials, labor, equipment, tools, transportation and services for construction of street and storm drain improvements on Ramona Avenue, North 10th Street, and Brighton Avenue in the City of Grover Beach. The project generally consists of construction of a complete and functional bus transit facility including: five (5) concrete bus parking spaces, 650 linear feet of storm drain, 38,000 square feet of asphalt concrete pavement, 14,000 square feet of miscellaneous concrete flatwork, 2,200 linear feet of miscellaneous concrete curbs and gutters, ADA ramps and railings, miscellaneous utility adjustments and relocations, and all auxiliary facilities in connection with such bus transit hub project.

All equipment and materials furnished shall be new. The City reserves the right not to award all bid items. The Contractor has complete and total responsibility to assure compliance with all safety rules and regulations. The City of Grover Beach, the Engineer, and the Project Engineer have no job-site safety responsibility.

Street improvements include, but are not limited to: clearing and grubbing, earthwork, miscellaneous concrete, storm drain construction, asphalt concrete paving, miscellaneous utility relocations, striping and signage, and bus shelters, as shown on the plans.

Broken concrete or asphalt or other deleterious material is to become the property of the Contractor and be disposed of outside the right-of-way in accordance with the Standard Specifications.

Such other items and details, not mentioned above, that are required by the plans, Standard Specifications or these Special Provisions shall be performed, placed, constructed or installed.

Bids are required for the entire work described herein. All bids are to be compared on the basis of the estimated quantities of work to be done contained in this proposal.

No bid will be accepted from a Contractor who has not been licensed in accordance with the provisions of State law. All bids must be made on a proposal form furnished by the City.

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Project: South County Transit Hub – Phase I

The successful bidder shall furnish a payment bond, a performance bond and a Certificate of Liability Insurance as required by these Special Provisions.

Pursuant to Section 1773 of the California Labor Code, the general prevailing rates of wages in the City of Grover Beach have been obtained from the Director of Industrial Relations of the STATE OF CALIFORNIA. Pursuant to Section 1773.2 of said Code said rates of wages are on file at City Hall and are available to any interested party on request.

The City reserves the right to reject any and all bids.
