**SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS –  
SOUTH COUNTY TRANSIT HUB *and*  
10<sup>th</sup> STREET PARKING IMPROVEMENT PROJECT**

The City is seeking Statements of Qualifications from qualified engineers/engineering firms to complete engineering design and bid documents for the South County Transit Hub and 10<sup>th</sup> Street Parking Improvement Project (the "Project"). The City encourages your participation in this Request for Qualifications solicitation process.

The City of Grover Beach consists of 2.25 square miles and is located on the Central Coast of California. It is approximately 12 miles south of the City of San Luis Obispo and 90 miles north of the City of Santa Barbara. The project is to be constructed adjacent to and in the vicinity of the Ramona Garden Park Center.

The Project will consist of the construction of, at minimum: 1) on-street bus facility to service four buses along Ramona Avenue between North 9<sup>th</sup> and North 10<sup>th</sup> Streets; 2) construction of street improvements in a two block area between North 8<sup>th</sup> and North 10<sup>th</sup> Streets along Ramona Avenue; 3) construction of parking improvements along the west side of North 10<sup>th</sup> Street between Ramona Avenue and Brighton Avenue and adjacent to Ramona Garden Park; and 4) construction of a storm drain lateral along North 9<sup>th</sup> Street between West Grand Avenue and Ramona Avenue.

Interested firms should present a Statement of Qualifications (SOQ) for the above-noted work. The submittal requirements and evaluation process are described in the Request for Qualifications document. SOQ documents must be received no later than **5:00 p.m. on Friday, October 26, 2007** and should be addressed as follows:
