A public workshop will be held on Monday, May 11, 2009 at 6:30 PM to discuss the update of Land Use Element of the General Plan. The Land Use Element sets forth a new vision for the future growth and development of the City, guided by the Visioning Project, stakeholder interviews and a previous workshop conducted in 2008.



The consultants who are preparing the plan will present a summary of their findings and recommendations, followed by an informal discussion of issues and alternatives. However, no formal action will be taken at the workshop. This is an opportunity for the City Council, Planning Commission, property owners and other interested parties to share ideas and discuss options.

Input received from the workshop will be used to refine the conclusions and recommendations to be incorporated into the Draft Land Use Element which is the subject of an Environmental Impact Report (EIR). Following the completion of the EIR, the Draft Land Use Element and Draft EIR will be considered by the Planning Commission and City Council at public hearings to be conducted in the fall.



Copies of the Draft Land Use Diagram and a summary of the issues will be available at the workshop.
