Beloved Music Festival Closes Out Summer in Grover Beach with Exciting Community Activities Coming in the Fall

Grover Beach, CA – As the summer season winds down, the City of Grover Beach Parks and Recreation Department is pleased to announce a robust schedule of outdoor community programs and activities for the fall. From live music to volunteer opportunities to athletic events and programs, there is something for everyone to enjoy over the next few months.
