NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Grover Beach encourages residents to apply for positions on City Commissions and Committees that have vacancies. When vacancies occur, the City actively recruits applicants for the positions by publishing Notices of Vacancies in the local newspapers and posting the notice in the City's three (3) public posting locations.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that:

One (1) vacancy will occur on the **Traffic Committee** with the expiration of the current two-year term (scheduled to expire on January 15, 2013).

The Traffic Committee is a body of four City staff members and one member of the public that meets monthly (as needed) on the second Thursday of each month to review traffic conditions / regulations within the City limits.

Interviews with interested applicants will be held before a City Screening Committee, with recommendations forwarded to the City Council for consideration and appointment(s) at a regular City Council meeting. Applicants must be registered voters of the City of Grover Beach.

Applications are available at the City Clerk's Office, Grover Beach City Hall, 154 South Eighth Street, Grover Beach and on the City website at www.grover.org. Applications will be reviewed and candidates interviewed by a Screening Committee before appointment is made by the Grover Beach City Council.
