

ORDINANCE 22-04

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVER BEACH, CALIFORNIA AMENDING CHAPTER 2 (COUNCIL COMPENSATION) OF ARTICLE II (ADMINISTRATION)

WHEREAS, Grover Beach Municipal Code Section 2201 provides that each Council Member shall receive \$600 per month as a salary and the Mayor shall receive \$750 per month as a salary; and

WHEREAS, members of City Council of the City of Grover Beach ("City") have not had an increase in salary since December 2018; and

WHEREAS, California Government Code section 36516 provides that the Council Members may increase their salaries by an ordinance in an amount not to exceed 5 percent for each calendar year from the operative date of the last increase;

WHEREAS, Council Members are entitled under the Government Code to approved a salary increase consistent with Government Code Section 36516 without constituting a conflict of interest.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Grover Beach as follows:

PART 1: Chapter 2 (Compensation), Section 2201 of Article II (Administration) of the Grover Beach Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 2201. Compensation of Council Members. Each member of the Council shall receive, as a salary, the sum of seven hundred twenty dollars (\$720) per month and, pursuant to Government Code section 36516.1, as may be amended from time to time, the directly elected Mayor shall receive, as a salary, nine hundred dollars (\$900) per month.


PART 2: Severability. If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance or any part thereof is for any reason held to be in violation of the law, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of this Ordinance or any part thereof. The City Council hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared in violation of the law.

PART 3: Effective Date. This Ordinance shall not become effective and in full force and effect until 12:01 a.m. on the thirty first day after its final passage. However, the increase in compensation shall become effective after the November 2022 General Municipal Election and when any member of Council commences their new term of office, and within fifteen (15) days after adoption by the City Council, the Ordinance shall be published once, together with the names of the Council Members voting thereon, in a newspaper of general circulation within the City.
