**SUBJECT: FINAL ACCEPTANCE OF THE 2015-1 STREET REHABILITATION AND REPAIR PROJECT**

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**BACKGROUND**

The 2015-1 Street Rehabilitation and Repair Project was approved for construction in July of 2015. The construction portion of the project totaled \$682,946.33 and was funded from Measure K14 bond funds. Project consists of construction of pavement and ancillary improvements on Brighton Avenue between North 13<sup>th</sup> Street and Oak Park Boulevard, on Nice Avenue between South 12<sup>th</sup> Street and South 13<sup>th</sup> Street, and South 7<sup>th</sup> Street between West Grand Avenue and Rockaway Avenue. The project, including punch list items, was completed on December 1, 2015.

**DISCUSSION**

As with all Public Works projects a workmanship and material guaranty for a period of twelve (12) months from the date of acceptance for all the items of work as designated in the Engineer's Estimate will be required. The guaranty will conform to the provisions in Section 2-1.12, "Material Guaranty," of the Standard Specifications. The City Engineer has deemed the project to be complete in accordance with the approved plans and Standard Specifications of the City of Grover Beach. If project is accepted by Council, the "Notice of Completion" will be forwarded to CalPortland Construction. That starts the 12-month warranty period.


**ALTERNATIVES**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVER BEACH, CALIFORNIA, FORMALLY ACCEPTING THE 2015-1 STREET REHABILITATION AND REPAIR PROJECT**

**WHEREAS**, in 2014, voters approved Measure K-14 to provide up to \$48 million in bond funds for rehabilitation of residential streets over the next 25-years; and

**WHEREAS**, in February of 2015, the City Council approved the first \$5 million bond issuance for the 2015 Street Rehabilitation and Repair Project; and

**WHEREAS**, in July of 2015, City Council awarded a contract for construction of the 2015-1 Street Rehabilitation and Repair Project to CalPortland Construction; and

**WHEREAS**, project consists of construction of pavement and ancillary improvements on Brighton Avenue between North 13<sup>th</sup> Street and Oak Park Boulevard, on Nice Avenue between South 12<sup>th</sup> Street and South 13<sup>th</sup> Street, and South 7<sup>th</sup> Street between West Grand Avenue and Rockaway Avenue; and

**WHEREAS**, construction of the project was completed in December of 2015, with a final cost of \$682,946.33; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Engineer has deemed the project to be complete in accordance with the approved plans and Standard Specifications of the City of Grover Beach.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Grover Beach hereby formally accepts the 2015-1 Street Rehabilitation and Repair Project, and authorizes staff to issue the "Notice of Completion" to CalPortland Construction.
